Picture a giant, hollow ball made of glass, completely indoors, surrounded by lights, and skewered through its middle by a footbridge. Now, stain the inside of the glass ball as if it were a political map of the Earth turned inside-out. You are inside the **Mapparium** at the Mary Baker Eddy Library. This huge globe shows the world's boundaries frozen in time circa 1935 - see how much has changed!
