Information for This Year at MILE (2022-2023)

- The **MILE Fall term** begins Tuesday, October 4th and ends on Thursday, November 17th. In-person classes will be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays at MxCC. ZOOM classes will be held on Wednesdays.

- The **fee for the upcoming year is \$65** per member for the whole academic year. This annual membership fee entitles one to attend all presentations offered in the fall, winter, and spring. It also makes the MILE trips available to you. This fall we are offering a bus trip to Olana & Stratsburgh Historic Site in The Hudson River Valley on Oct. 12 and a day trip to the Connecticut State Library in Hartford, CT on Nov. 2. - You may invite people who are not MILE members to accompany you on the Hudson Valley Trip. **You must register and pay for the trip (\$142.00) on or before Orientation on September 9.**

- We are always in need of **volunteers to be monitors** for our presentations. You may sign up at Orientation on Sept. 9th. Monitors perform important functions: (1) post signs with the name and location of the presentation, (2) greet our members, (3) sign-in members and their guests and check badges which are needed to ensure the security of our members and the college, and (4) collect fees for forgotten badges (25 cents), as well as donations for the Extra Mile Fund. **Monitors receive a list of duties** and any information they need via email the weekend before the presentation
